

#### PLAY READING COMMITTEE 101

The purpose of the Play Reading Committee simply is to review scripts that are submitted by SLCT directors (and other interested parties) to be determined by the Committee as to whether or not it

is suitable for production before a Sun Lakes Community audience. That being stated, the guidelines for evaluating and reviewing scripts are as follows: Subject matter should not contain anything that could be offensive to Sun Lakes audiences; Subject matter should be relevant to Sun Lakes audiences; Consideration of the size of the space and set design is also taken into consideration. More information appears on our slctinfo website under the heading of "resources".

Play Reading Committee participation is a crucial factor for a successful production of a play submitted to it by an SLCT director. Every committee

member has an obligation to review each play and report back to the chairperson their evaluation. The committee is basically the gatekeeper for the theatre. It is a three year responsibility and obligation that is taken seriously.

Once the committee receives a play read request the fun begins. As the play review is underway a decision is made by each committee member evaluating it suitability for the Sun Lakes audience and if there is a tie decision the committee will convene to go over and talk out their evaluations. At times the director will also have input into the committee and hash out differences of opinions. Not an easy process but it does require an air and platform for further discussion.

#### ADVANCED ACTING CLASS RETURNS!!

The Advanced Acting Class is returning in September by popular demand!! Those class members who took it last year did not want to wait another whole year to take it again! It was such a fun, challenging and worthwhile class. Our instructor, Karen Burns, encourages her students to understand character and relationships within a scene, to react, to live in the moment, and to apply these to the various components of monologue and scene study.

It is a very valuable class for those actors who are serious about acting and who have had significant roles in shows. "You can never stop learning and practicing the art of acting!!"

Advanced Acting will run on Saturday mornings, September 9 through October 21, from 10 am until noon. (There is no class on Sat. Oct. 14 in order to allow scene partners time to rehearse their scenes.)
