We were all very sorry to hear that Larry Kelinson died March 20, 2010 at the Dobson House. Larry and his wife of 22 years Gloria, SLCT's make-up and hair artist, moved to Sun Lakes in 2001. One of the first organizations they joined that year was the Sun Lakes Community Theatre. His last duty with SLCT was making sure that any audience member needing a special hearing device for that performance would receive one. He was very sick even then, but he wanted so much to help us in any way he could. Larry has truly suffered for many years with emphysema, bronchitis and asthma and was in and out of the hospital constantly. Larry proudly served his country courageously in both the Army and the Air Force and was a highly decorated serviceman including the Purple Heart. Before he retired, his profession was as a retail salesman in men's clothing. Other activities Larry thoroughly enjoyed doing was playing poker and bridge. Private interment was at the National Memorial Cemetery of Arizona on Wednesday, March 24, 2010 at 12:30 pm. We will miss his sweet smile.
