

Mousetrap has been buried, and sprouting from that same ground are **Tomatoes**. The seeds were planted a year ago. These vegetables have a long germination period. But soon the sprouts will be surfacing as seven actors, two directors and 20+ tech people begin their creative tilling. This means that ***A Bad Year for Tomatoes*** is about to re-group. Rehearsals don't begin until January, but posters, set designs and costume plans are all receiving a re-birth. **Tomatoes** performance dates are Tuesday March 8th through Saturday, March 12th.
