A Bad Year for Tomatoes is a hilarious "fish-out-of-water" comedy in which the main character, a Hollywood character actress, escapes to a small rural village to "find herself." Instead, she finds a collection of rural characters curious about the new lady in town. Two local gossips, a woman trained in the occult, and a rustic woodcutter make her stay in Beaver Haven more like a nightmare.

Written by John Patrick, (*Teahouse of the August Moon* and *A Curious Savage*), it contains some of Patrick's most hysterical situations and dialogue. "Tomatoes" is directed by Penny Petersen. The Hollywood character actress, Myra Marlow, is played by Laura Eisenhart.

The gossipy neighbors are played by Andrea Hummel and Janine Schneck. Phyllis Novy appears as the third female neighbor. Her character is known for sticking pins into dolls representing people, including her husband who died without telling her where he hid the deed to the house.

Jim Dittmann plays Piney, who delivers wood, traps skunks and kills hogs. Bob Rouleau plays Tom, the manager and hopeful lover of Myra. He believes Myra is crazy and repeatedly, without success, tries to talk her into returning to Hollywood. Michael Carter plays the bossy and authoritative sheriff who doesn't know which kookie character in this situation to believe.
