Auditions for three male parts and three female parts takes place on September 10 at 1pm in the San Tan ballroom. Copies of the script are available from John Crawford, either in hard copy or as an online document for those of you who enjoy computer based documents.

In a nutshell, the cast will consist of the following characters:

- CHUCK Successful author of mystery plays...widower, and brother to:
- TERRY A mid-life “finally going to college” brother living with Chuck and the housekeeper:
- GLINDA The feisty long-time housekeeper who helps Chuck survive as a widower even though his status as a widower is under assault by:
- YOLANDA An aggressive single woman seeing to seduce Chuck into marriage with a sense of growing desperation as Chuck begins to pay attention to:
- CHARITY A respected theatre critic who happens to hate the characters in Chuck’s popular mystery plays but finds herself falling in love with Chuck as he helps her learn to write her own mystery play with “real” characters.
- WAITER Seven unique “brothers” who wait tables in luncheon locales from posh to putrid as Chuck and Charity slowly spend several months falling in love.

The production run for 100 LUNCHES will begin with a matinee opening on Tuesday November 1 at 1:00pm. Evening performances will follow at 7pm on Wednesday with dinner opportunities added to the festivities for Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Sunday the 6<sup>th</sup> we will strike the set and have a party.
