Longtime Member Barbara Hazlett Acting Again!

This year is Barb Hazlett's 20th anniversary of involvement with theatre in Sun Lakes. Born in Panama (her father was military – Air Force), Barbara was used to making new friends. When she and husband Doug moved to Phoenix in 1979, "I used theatre as a place to meet people," she said, "And it always worked."



After settling in Phoenix, Barb worked with Stagebrush Players in Scottsdale, TheatreWorks in Glendale and Phoenix Little Theatre on Central Ave. She acted, directed and taught theatre and TV classes.

Represented by the Plaza Three Talent Agency, she did professional acting, modeling, commercials and print work. She even landed a part in a made-for-TV movie shown on ABC. The title was *A Mother's Revenge* and starred Leslie Anne Warren. One of the better perks of her career at Plaza Three, where she also taught classes, was being hired for travel brochure work. She and Doug were both hired and got a free cruise to Hawaii. Barb also went to Alaska and Doug went to the Panama Canal for work through Plaza Three.

And all of that was prior to 1991 when the Hazletts moved to Sun Lakes. Shortly thereafter, Barb joined the small group interested in theatre. What was then called Sun Lakes Players had been in existence since fall of 1988 when they produced *Lost At Sea*, but they had no home theatre and were a loosely knit group. Early productions were at the old café at Cottonwood, prior to the construction of the San Tan Ballroom. Then, some were done at Sunbird and Oakwood.

Both Barbara and Doug appeared in the fall l991 production of *Man with the Plastic Sandwich*. Barb played a hooker. But during rehearsals, she hurt her back and could hardly stand up. She came onstage with a cane and said, "My John just beat me up!" Everybody thought it was part of the script. The couple appeared together again in 1992 in *Plaza Suite* where they played the Hollywood producer and his old girlfriend.

By 1992, the little group had grown and Barb remembers Rita Arrow, Patti Landers, Don Westin, Ennie Smart, Jim Dunn, Veda Baack, Bob Morris, Gwen Baily, Jim Percival, and Shirley Fulcher as some of the regulars on the stage and behind the scenes.

From an actor's standpoint, Barb has taken on some of the best roles written. In *Arsenic & Old Lace* (about ten years ago which was put on at Sunbird), she played one of the sisters; in *The Curious Savage*, she was Mrs. Savage, in *Sylvia*, she was the scene-stealing drunk friend; and *In Bench in the Sun* she portrayed Adrienne Bliss, the only

female. In the production of *The Night of January 16th*, which she directed, she ended up playing the leading lawyer role when Jim Dunn became too ill to perform.

Barb's talent as a director was quickly recognized and she directed, **You Can't Take It With You** (at Sunbird), **The Night of January 16**th (at Oakwood), **Because Her Heart Was Pure**, (Sun Lakes CC --she had a small role and ended up directing when Patti Landers got sick), and **Over the River and Thru the Woods** (Cottonwood), her favorite because it was so much fun.

In addition to acting Barb and Doug were each elected president of the organization, and Barb served several times on the Board.

A prolonged break was forced on Barb due to five back surgeries. A second break came when Doug was diagnosed with cancer (Mesothelioma). He passed away in May of 2011.

But now Barb's back! She will appear as Glinda in the fall production of **100 Lunches.** "I've performed with and directed some wonderful actors including Grace Norris, Noel Rayburn, Veda Baack and Wes Davis. I'm glad to be back on stage. I've missed my theatre friends."
