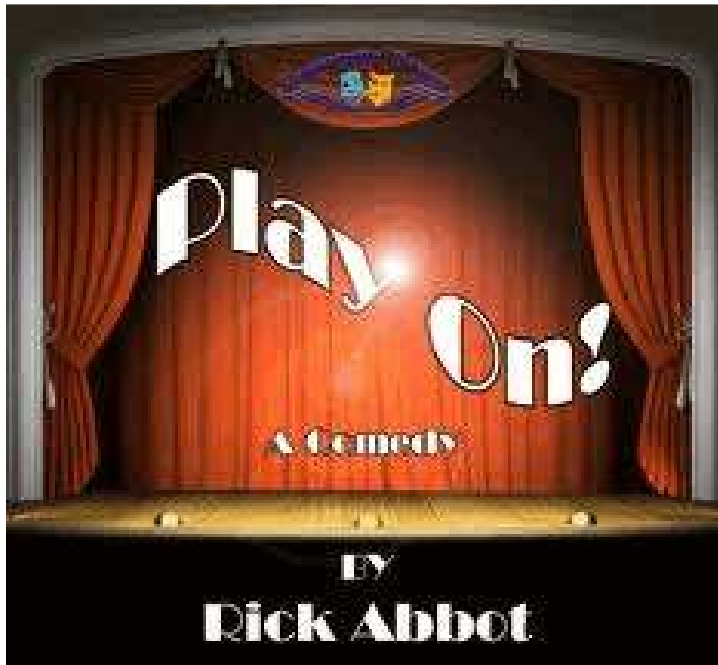
HAPPY HALF HOUR CONTINUES!!

Improvables IS WORKING HARD!

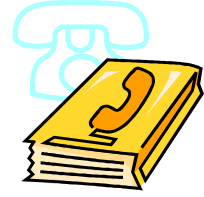
