JANUARY 10, 2013

CALL TO ORDER: 7PM

WELCOME: Linda Caton welcomed the general membership to the first meeting of the New Year.

INTRODUCTION OF NEW MEMBERS AND GUESTS: Linda introduced several new members and guests totaling about seven all together.

APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER MINUTES: A motion was made by Penny Petersen and seconded by Janine Schneck to approve the minutes of November's general meeting. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT: Kathy Jones was introduced as the new treasurer replacing Jeanne Schwan. Kathy reported that the fall play "Murder at Café Noir" directed by Sandy Pallett net income was \$8890. The approximate total in our account is \$28000. Kathy also reported that SLCT is in the process of changing banks from Chase to Wells Fargo. Once all checks drawn through Chase have cleared the transition will then be complete.

KUDOS FOR A GREAT HOLIDAY PARTY: Linda thanked Howard Hummel and Sandy Pallett for the great job they did in pulling together a wonderful holiday party that was held at Palo Verde.

SPRING PLAY "DEARLY BELOVED": Howard Hummel is directing the spring play "Dearly Beloved". Howard reported that the play runs from March 6 through March 10 with ticket sales beginning February 18<sup>th</sup>. The play takes place at a wedding preparation in South Texas with many interesting and quirky characters. A call for help to anyone from the membership who would like to assist with lighting set construction, etc. will be appreciated.

UPDATE ON ELECTION: Bud Jenssen reported that there are three board seats that will be vacant for the next term and there are five candidates who have agreed to run thus far. The five candidates are: Sandy Ilsen, Sandy

A committee to work on this project is necessary and all volunteers are appreciated to step forward. A business plan and a budget are the first steps required prior to looking for grants/funding.
