Sun Lakes Community Theatre General Membership Meeting Held in the Saguaro Room - Cottonwood March 18, 2015 – 6:30 pm

Call to Order: Sandy Bocynesky called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Welcome: Sandy B. welcomed members. New member Susan Schleslingo introduced herself.

Minutes of February 2015 General Meeting: Motion made, seconded and approved to accept minutes as printed.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Kathy Jones presented the Treasurer's Report, a copy of which was distributed on each table. Total cash is at present \$32,256.15. Motion made, seconded and approved to accept the report as presented.

Board Elections: Jim Nielsen asked members to fill out ballots and place them in the ballot box.

Accomplishments During Past Year: Recap to be presented at the end of year celebration on April 7.

Position Vacancies:

Historian: If interested, talk to Kathy Jones. Joan Berger volunteered, with Barry Berger to assist with photos.

Volunteer Coordinator: To provide information, answer questions about SLCT dues, meeting dates, etc.

Script Reading Committee: Three vacancies on committee need to be filled as three members' terms are up.

Shed Restoration: John Crawford declared March 26, beginning at 8:00 am, as Shed Restoration Day. Email blast will be sent requesting help to inventory furniture, costumes and props, and transfer of some items to air conditioned shed.

Shows: Summer show is scheduled. Still looking for directors for the fall and spring shows. Performing at Oakwood or Sun Lakes I: Pros: performing outside Cottonwood acquaints more Sunlakers with SLCT, bridges gap between phases, makes money for SLCT, attracts new audience members. Cons: no storage facility for sound and lighting equipment which must be moved back and forth from Cottonwood each performance. Is a strain on those having to lift the heavy equipment, which could be damaged during the hauling.

<u>Publicity</u>: Most response comes from advertising in Splash. Jim Nielsen reported he has captured email addresses of ticket buyers, enabling him to send out notices of future performances. Lots of effort has gone into emails and on-line sales, which were 20% of tickets sold for *Southern Hospitality*.

Hamilton High School: A group of students from Hamilton High School performed. SLCT's check for \$1,000 was presented to their Drama Dept.

Improv Group: Expense for Improv T-Shirts on SLCT Treasurer's Report was questioned. It was explained that Improv folks contributed \$30 of their own money when the group formed which is held in the account in order to purchase new shirts. The money Improv collects for performances goes into SLTC's treasury, but the accounting is kept separate to cover Improv costumes and cast parties. The remainder of funds are in the general accounting

Board Minutes: Copies of Board minutes are not published in the Asides, as are General Meeting Minutes, but are retained on-line in the Archives section under www.slctinfo.com. Any SLCT member can request a copy of the Board minutes. Board actions are reported at the general meetings.

Election Results: Ted Peck and Michael Carter have been elected to fill the vacancies of the two terms which have expired. Board will speak briefly, after meeting adjournment, with the newly elected candidates.

Reminders: Chorale Concert is March 20. Chordaires Show is April 12. End of Year Party is April 7 and deadline is April 3 to make reservation with Treasurer Kathy Jones. Auditions for Summer Play will be April 18.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 pm.

If you have performed improv before or taken an improv class or workshop - this workshop is for you!


If you have NEVER taken a class or done anything like this before - this workshop is *also* for you!!
