MJ has prepared the following graphic from which you can choose your style of shirt(s). Also, here is the order form from which you can choose your size, number of shirts, and prices.

#### Process:

- 1. Please print yourself a copy of the information form and fill it in (or) write your order with your name on a piece of paper.
- 2. Write a check for the correct total amount for the shirt(s) you wish to order.
- 3. Put them in an envelope, stamp it, and send by U.S. mail to me: Bill Becker, 9323 E. Citrus Lane N., Sun Lakes, AZ 85296
- 4. When I receive your order and your check as payment in advance, I will add it to the final order to be submitted to the vendor.
- 5. **Please remit your order to me by Saturday, September 25, 2021,** which gives everyone several weeks to submit orders. Then, I will have a few days to finalize the total order and submit it to the vendor. The processing time will take approximately 10 days, and I will pick them up from the vendor.
- 6. **At 6:00 pm at the October 14 SLCT General Meeting** in the Saguaro Room at Cottonwood, I will distribute the shirts that you ordered.

The group performs in Chandler elementary schools January thru March, ending the week of Dr. Seuss' birthday. Bringing theater to the schools, especially those in underprivileged areas, allows students to experience live theater, often for the very first time. Each year, we perform at about 22-24 schools and reach, on average, approximately 2,400 kindergarten and first grade students. Join the fun and monkey around with us!
