Grant report – Cindi

There will probably be no more grants until 2022.
The last grant report is due August 2nd. The \$6000 grant we received can be used for anything,
while the \$1000 grant must be used for productions.

Summer show last week of July – Sandy

The summer show will be "Old Time Radio", directed by Roger Edmonds. We have the San Tan Ballroom from July 25 to July 31. The show will run July 27 to July 31 with load-in July 25 and dress rehearsal July 26. Auditions will be held in Cottonwood room A6 Wednesday May 12 from 9:00am until 11:30am.
MJ reports that there are enough tech people available for the July show and that she has new street signs which weigh about 40 pounds less than the old ones. Cottonwood has put some new restrictions on where they can be put, so she will find out what the current rules are.

Sally Holberg will direct a dance Flash Mob. Sandy is getting approvals from some venues to do this. Rehearsals will be at the Oakwood dance studio. The first one is 4:00pm on Tuesday, May 11 with another at 12:00pm Wednesday, May 12.
