In fact, Chandler Recreation Manager contacted Phyllis, the director of the ImproVables, and asked them to perform at the Chandler Senior Center in May 2025.

Spring Show – Kate reported that there will be three On-Acts on April 30 – May 4, 2025 for our spring show. Directors will meet tomorrow and announce auditions and rehearsal schedules. Members need to contact the directors to get a script. Specifics of these one-acts were sent out in a prior email.

Children's Theater – More than half-way through now. Someone needs to step-up for directing this group for next year since it is so valuable to the kids and community.

Other Business – Kate mentioned that at the next GMM we will discuss the possibility of changing the by-laws to state that if someone has been a member of SLCT, but yet then moves outside of Sun Lakes, SunBird or Robson Reserve of Sun Lakes, that they can continue to pay dues, be active in the group and continue to be a member of SLCT.
