Business Discussed:

- Approval of last month's minutes. Motion made to approve, first, seconded and approved.
- Spring Show - Howard Hummel - "The Mouse that Roared" auditions this coming Saturday. The play has 14-30 parts - speaking and non-speaking roles. Encouraged ALL to audition.
- Recognition of new members to SLCT. Each told a bit about themselves and their experience/interest in theater. Special appreciation to Jess who rounded up many of them at the four Open Houses she coordinated and attended. This brings our membership to approximately 109.
- Several other "shout-outs" for those that are a big help - Barry (new directory of members coming out soon). Lew, Rick and Greg for wearing costumes at the Open Houses and John Zoeller for ticket sales.
- Financial Overview - Fall show unaudited gross ticket sales: \$14,625. SLCT total in bank at end of October: \$49,086.
- Children's Theatre - Sandy Bocynesky encouraged ALL to audition and be a part of our fun service to 28 Chandler Public schools on T, W, Th mornings from early January - early March 2025. Scripts available now.
- Variety Show - Nancy Patterson called for acts to contact her if they would like to be a part of the show March 8 & 9, 2025.
- ImproVables - Phyllis Novy reviewed many of the upcoming shows and we thank her so much for her work. All shows have been sell-outs.
- Play Reading Committee members/Script Search Sub-Committee - Kate King-Turner will be contacting play reading committee interested people to delve into finding new scripts for directors. There is a small budget for this project. Anyone interested should contact Kate.
- Amendment to By-laws: "membership shall be open to residents of these Robson Properties: Sun Lakes, Sun Bird & Robson Reserve." Kate read the current By-Laws and discussed that the wording needed more clarity. With at least 42 members present tonight, motion was made to approve the above amendment, first, seconded and voted on.
