Minutes of the Last Meeting: The minutes of last month's meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The report for September showed we have total funds of \$36,460 including a \$15,000 CD. The report was approved.

Membership Report: We have one new member recruited from Sandy B's plan to open a rehearsal to non-members.

Banking Request: We have had a number of questions about using internet based banking for payments like dues. Greg and Nancy agreed to visit Wells Fargo to learn what is required for us to make use of these services.

Debrief of Last General Meeting: Feedback was generally positive. Members were engaged with the business at hand. Public recognition of outstanding volunteers and their efforts was a strong positive.

There is general recognition amongst many in the Sun Lakes community that the show Twelve Angry Jurors was excellent from the viewpoints of play selection and acting. This led member Mario Carranza to suggest maybe we should look into plays based on the law. There were two suggestions. One is a book that was developed as a play titled On the Night of January 16th. It was performed as a trial with the audience acting as the jury. Kate will find the name of the other play.

The availability of rehearsal space was also discussed at the general meeting. We identified a number of candidates that could be a long term solution. The list included

the Lutheran church being used for Horton rehearsals, Chapel House in HOA #1 and the spaces used by New Adventures in Learning. Greg will head a committee to look unto solutions to this problem.

Technology: Dave Patterson's request for sound equipment was approved.

Apology to Patrons of the October 4 ImproVables Show at SLCC:

There were many complaints about both the quality and quantity of food served by SLCC at this show. Further discussion revealed that some of the problems may have arisen from the what and how we asked the SLCC to do. However we feel that the overall service was severely lacking.

Kate was to meet with the management at SLCC the afternoon of this meeting. We agreed that depending on the outcome of this meeting we will send an apology to all the patrons who bought tickets to the performance and ask them to pass the apology on to the people for whom they may have bought tickets.

Other Business: Anna asked what we should tell people who want to join, but are discouraged by the lack of acting opportunities in the near future. Multiple Board members pointed out it takes many more people to keep SLCT operating than just actors.

We will be donating 4 passes to the Sun Lakes Foundation for their fund raising celebration. MJ and John have the action to do this.
